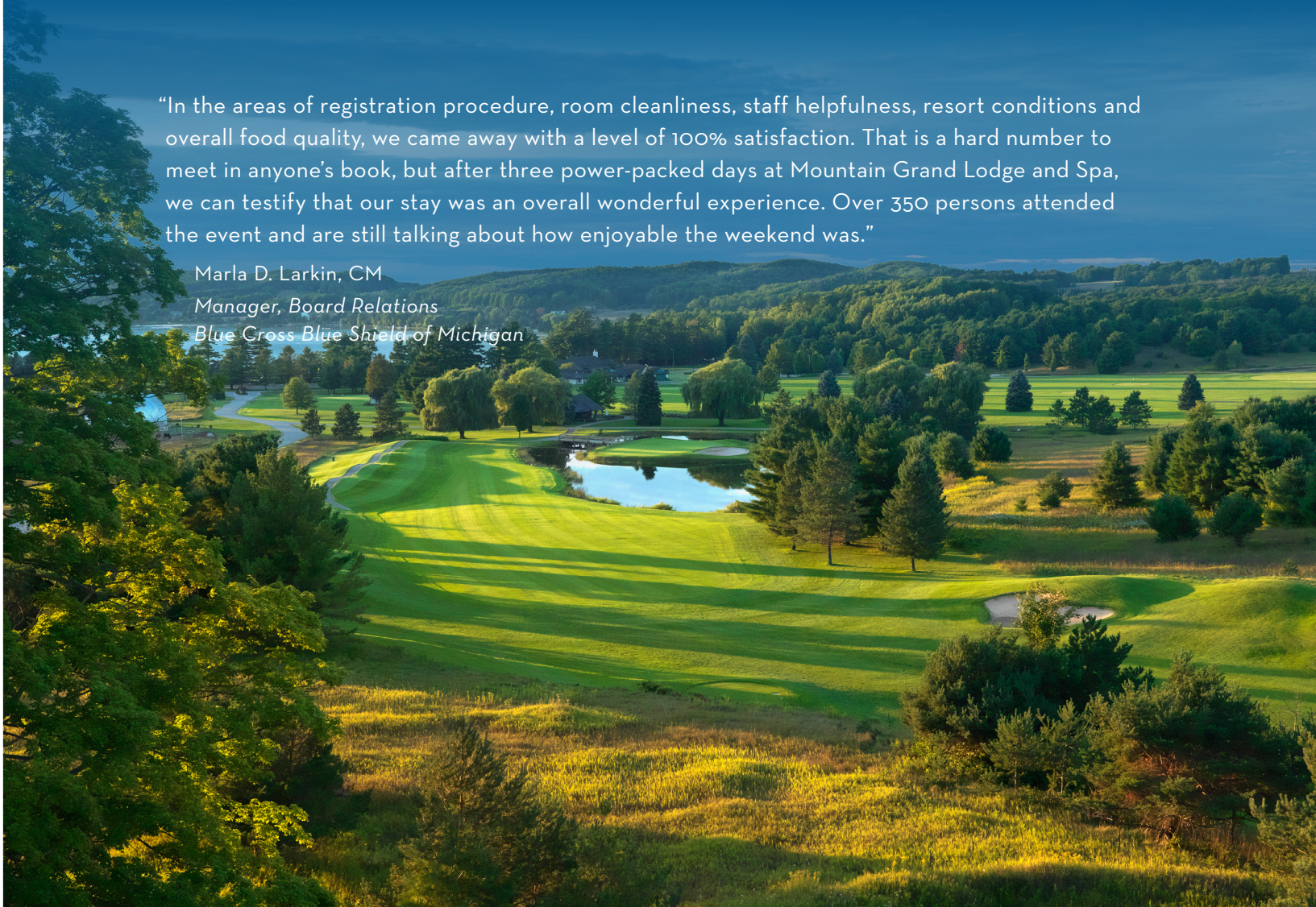
REJUVENATE

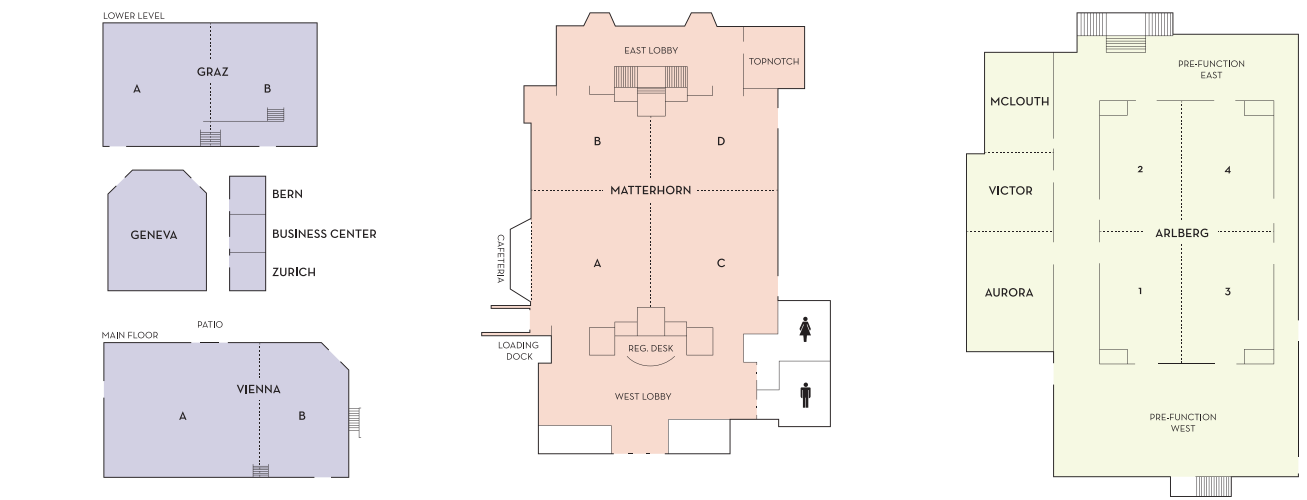
